Growing on to Finish

Professional potting media

Prefers soil kept evenly moist – keep at level 3. Never allow plant to fully dry or plant may get leaf tip burn	
Medium feed level 100-200ppm 1-2 times a week	
Supplemental lighting not required, natural daylength is all that is needed for bulking.	
Flowering is obligate long day.	
Growing: 65-75F days/ 55-65F nights	
Holding: 65+F	
Spider mites, caterpillars on both and thrips on flowerheads of Chelone glabra	
No real disease issues, occasionally powdery mildew can arise	
Yes, vernalization beneficial. Chill containers 14 weeks around 41F	
Trim shortly after planting to encourage branching	

Grower Tips:

- Chelone requires vernalization to flower. Purchasing pre-vernalized plugs in spring or ordering plugs in fall to bulk and then place in a protected greenhouse for overwintering will allow plants to be ready earlier for green spring sales.
- Slow to break dormancy. Provide a consistent warm greenhouse 65+ Do not allow crops to experience cold temps when breaking dormancy, crop will go into a second dormant state.
- PGRs found to be ineffective at height management
