| Media: | Professional potting media |
| pH: | 5.8-6.2 |
| EC: | 2.0-3.0 pour through method |
| Irrigation: | Provide consistent moisture without overwatering. Moderate moisture needs. |
| Fertilizer: | 75-100 ppm N constant liquid feed. Too much fertilization will result in lanky plants. |
| Light: | High light levels, long day obligate. |
| Temperature: | Growing: 65-70F Holding: 55-60F |
| Pest & Disease: | Powdery mildew, downy mildew, leaf spots, rust, viruses, crown rot, root rot, downy mildew. Scout for Aphids, Spider Mites, and Thrips. |
| Vernalization: | Not required |
| Pinching: | Give one pinch after planting to encourage branching |

Grower Tips:

- Will flower first year without cold treatment
- Plants can be trimmed after blooming for repeat flowering on bench
