Growing On to Finish	
Media	Type: Media with good aeration & drainage pH: 5.8 – 6.2 EC: Low
Irrigation	Allow media to dry slightly between watering; Never saturate.
Fertilizer	Mid rate CRF. Not heavy feeders.
Light	High
Temperature	Rooting Out: 65–80°F Growing: 65–80°F Holding: 40–50°F
Pest & Disease	None
Common Problems	None
