## **Growing on to Finish**

Media:	Professional potting media
pH:	5.8-6.5
Irrigation:	Requires average to moderate moisture. Water as needed when the plants are young and becoming established. It is best to allow growing medium to dry out slightly between irrigations.
Fertilizer:	Fertility can be delivered using water soluble or controlled release fertilizers. Water soluble fertilizers should be applied at high rates (200-300ppm) of nitrogen as needed, or feed with a constant liquid fertilization program at rates of 75-150ppm nitrogen with every irrigation. Darwin Fertilize at every other irrigation with 14-0-14 at 100-150ppm. Ball Redbook
Light:	Requires long days to flower. Grow under high light levels for best results.
Temperature:	Rooting out: 65-70F Growing: 65-70°F days/ 60-65°F nights Holding: 50-60°F
Pest & Disease:	Aphids, sawflies, whiteflies (greenhouse), thrip, beetles, plant bugs, stalk borers, aster leafhopper. Rot (Sclerotium), leaf spots, bacterial blight(Pseudomonas, Xanthomonas), Botrytis Blight, aster yellows, downy mildew.

## **Grower Tips:**

- Vernalization is not required but providing 8-10 weeks of cold is beneficial to increase bud count and uniformity. Plants receiving cool treatment flower three weeks sooner than non-vernalized plants
- Rudbeckia plants must attain a minimum of ten leaf nodes before flower induction begins
- Rudbeckia requires long-days (14hrs daylength) in order to flower
